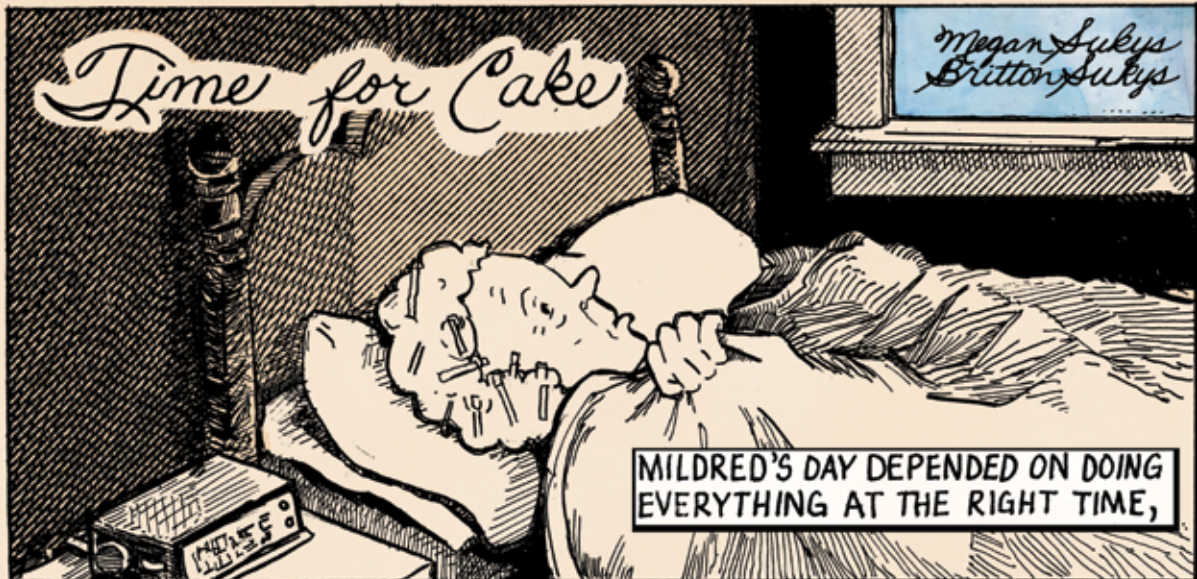

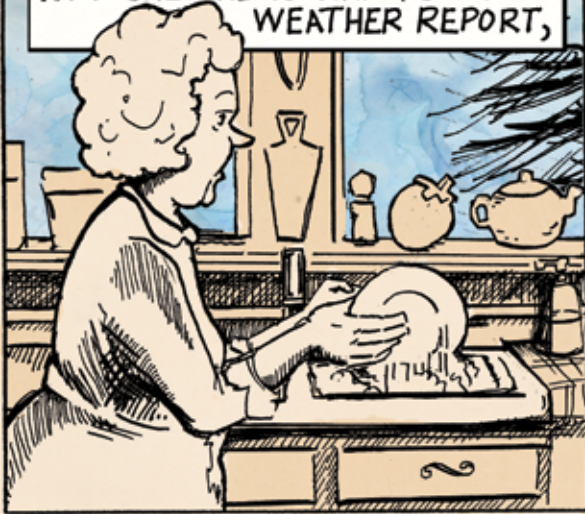
MILDRED'S DAY DEPENDED ON DOING EVERYTHING AT THE RIGHT TIME,



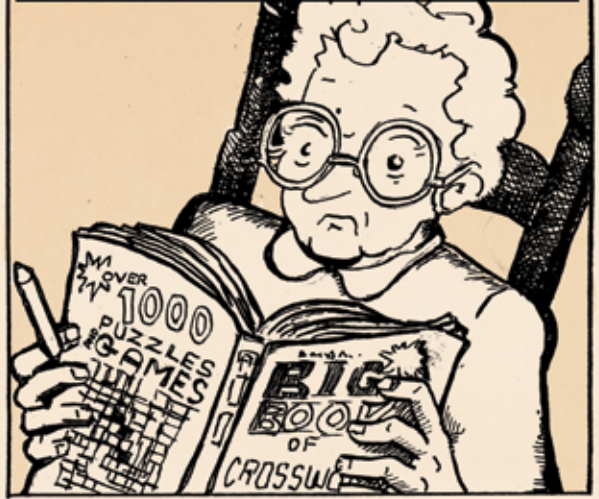

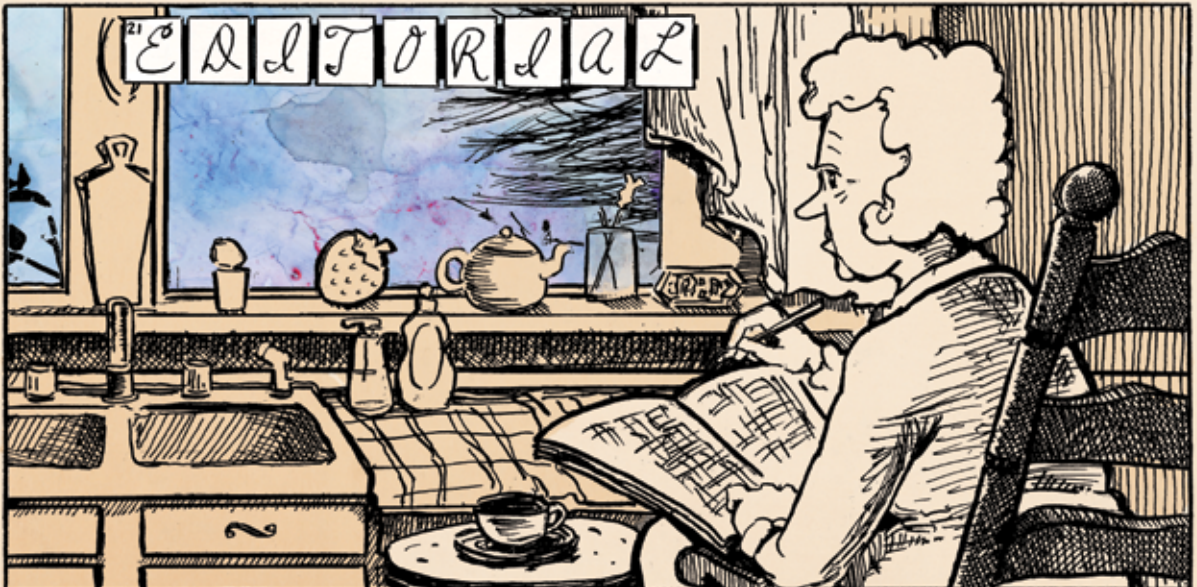
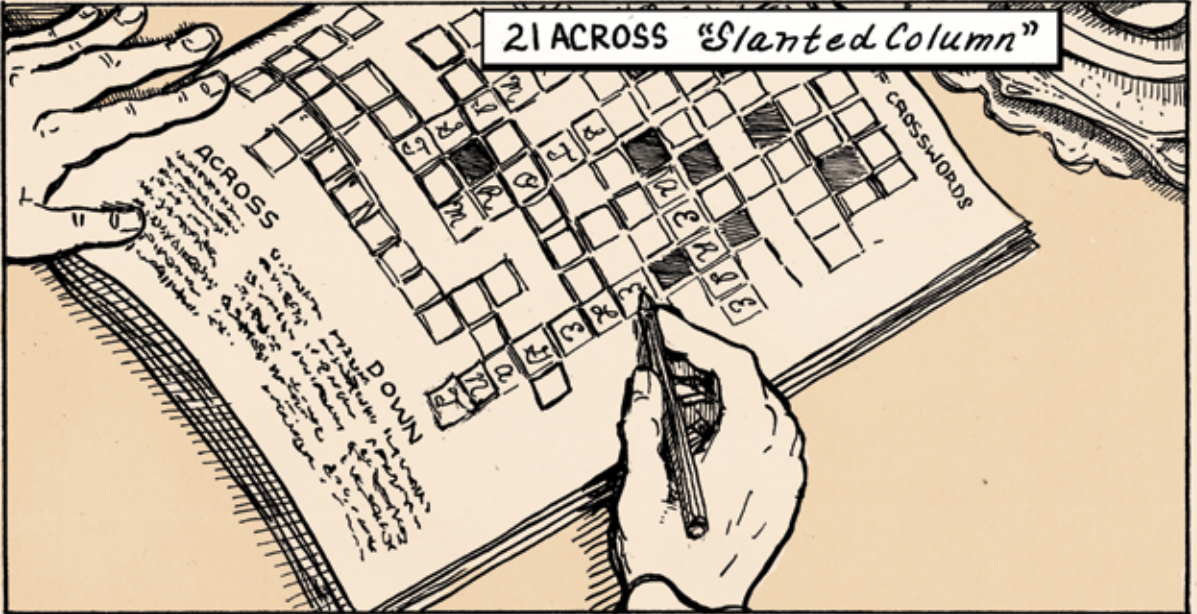
MILDRED COULDN'T REMEMBER WHY SHE HAD TO WAIT FOR THE WEATHER REPORT,

Pound Cake
2 sticks butter
3 c. sugar
5 eggs

- 3 c. flour ^{sift 3 times}
- 1 t. baking powder
- 1 c. milk ^{mix}
- 1 t. vanilla

Cream butter and sugar.
Add eggs, 1 at a time, beat well.
Add flour and milk mixtures,
in parts, alternating.
Bake at 350° in greased tubular
pan for 1 hour.
